This is a local event with a difference, to give a pleasant aftertaste to the JK.

The map above is an extract from Jim Prowting's previous depiction at a scale of 1:3750 and 2.5m intervals. Now he has gone one better: 1:2500 / 1.25m

The terrain is a former tin mine that is a profusion of gullies, knolls and depressions, graphically described by Brian Parker as 'chaotic terrain'. Brian was the mapper of the rather less detailed 1:10000 version, with virtually no contours used, but totally appropriately mapped for the smaller scale.

Burnt gorse branches in this totally open area are the only impediment to runnability, apart, of course, from the 'chaotic' topography!
